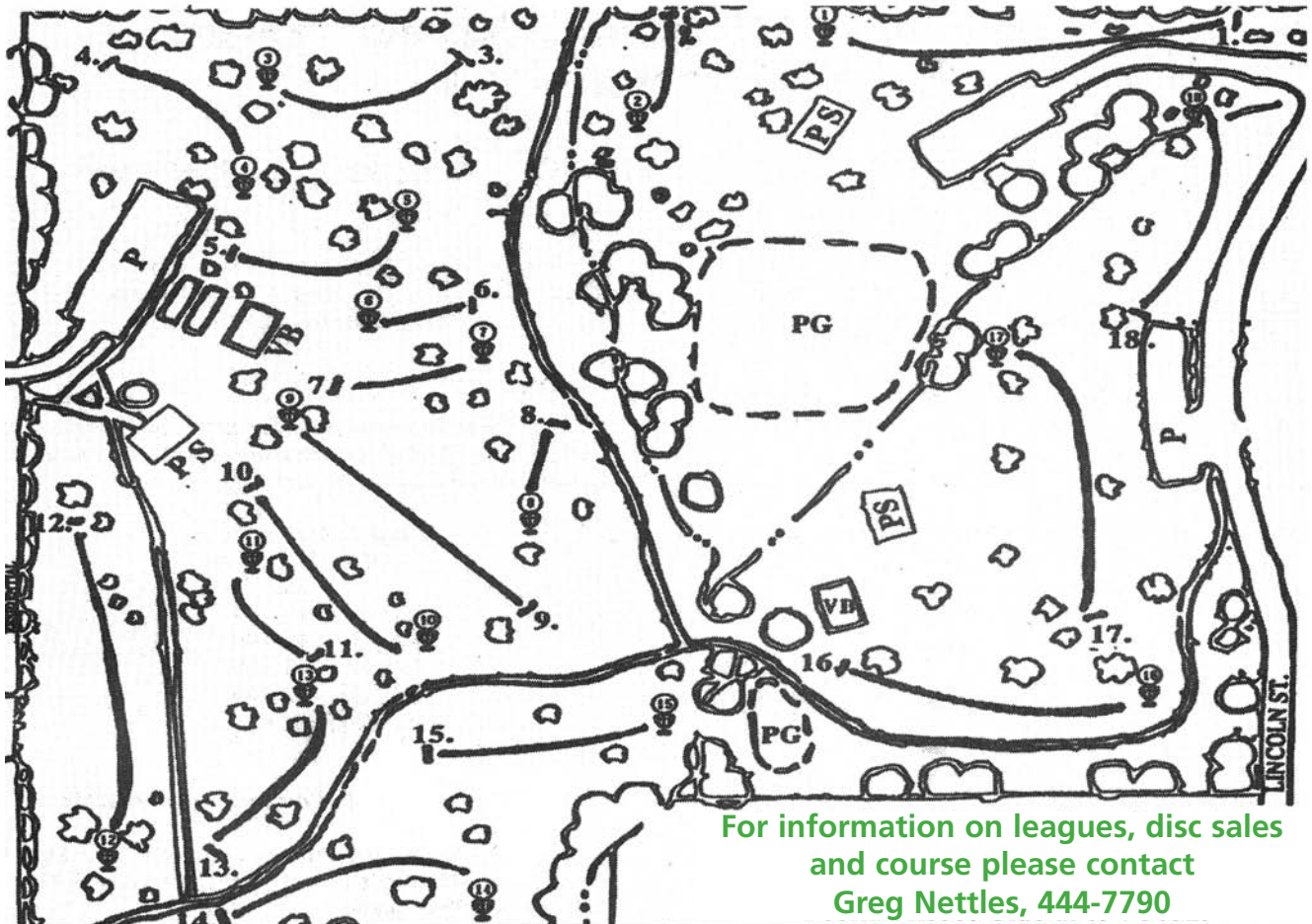

### Disc Golf Rules

**General:** Disc golf is played like ball golf using a flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown.

**Tee Throws:** Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area. Lie: The spot on or directly underneath the spot where the previous throw landed.

**Throwing Order:** After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole.

**Dog Leg:** A dog leg is one or more designated trees or poles in the fairway that must be passed on the outside when approaching the hole. Until the dog leg is passed, the closest foot to the dog leg must be on the lie when the disc is released.

**Putt:** Within 3 meters of the pole a player may not step past the point of his lie in making a putt. Falling or jumping putts are not allowed.

**Completion of the Hole:** A disc that comes to rest in the pole hole constitutes successful completion of the hole.

**Unplayable Lie:** Any disc that comes to rest more than 2 meters above ground is considered an unplayable lie. The disc must be thrown from the new lie on the ground directly underneath the unplayable lie (one throw penalty).

**Out of Bounds:** A throw that lands out of bounds must be played from the last place it went out of bounds. Streets, parking lots, creeks, lakes, etc are all considered out of bounds.
