We have recently reviewed each of our programs and will be transitioning to a new format of 2 days per week for the 5 hours per day. Starting with the 2021-2022 school year we will be offering the following structure on a weekly basis. We will still be following the Central District 51 school schedule. Participants may choose from one of the two options but will NOT be eligible to choose both. This program will still follow the same guidelines as previous years putting students in a position to be well-prepared for Kindergarten.

We strive to accomplish the following: Participation in educational, hands-on activities to develop and master current Kindergarten readiness skills aligned with area school district curriculum.

What is the fee structure?

The tuition will be broken down into 4 separate payments with payment being due at the time of registration.

Monday/Wednesday (holidays)

Payment 1 - \$275, Payment 2 - \$550, Payment 3 - \$350, Payment 4 - \$575

Tuesday/Thursday

Payment 1 - \$300, Payment 2 - \$550, Payment 3 - \$400, Payment 4 - \$575

Where will this be held?

Washington Park District Recreational Facility room #208 that is specifically designed to assist with the learning process and fits the needs of the children.

What ages will you accept?

4-5 year olds through June 1st. We will then open registration to 3-5 year olds. Age of 4-5 is based on program start date (mid-August). We encourage kids to be entering Kindergarten the following school year.

Do the students have to be toilet trained?

Yes

How many students will be in the classroom?

We have a 20 student maximum with a 10:1 students to teacher ratio.

Will there be snacks for the kids during the day?

Yes, a snack will be provided each morning.

What will be done for lunch?

Students will be asked to bring a sack lunch and drink/water bottle each day.

Does the program offer any physical activities?

Organized gym time and playground time will be in the daily lesson plan. Students will have time to be kids.

Will there be a rest time?

A designed time will be provided at the beginning of the school year for students to rest each day.

What will the children be learning?

Academic and Kindergarten readiness skills utilizing the "Learning Without Tears Pre-K" curriculum.

Will there be any sort of field trips?

There will be 1-2 field trips during the course of the school year.

Is this program for Washington residents?

The program will be available for families living in Washington and surrounding communities.

Who will be the Pre-K teacher?

Mrs. Natalie Carr is a Certified Elementary Education Teacher with early childhood experience.

Will Before/After Care be available?

10 hours per week in our programs is the maximum time available for this age. Students will need to be dropped off at 9:00am and picked up at 2:00pm.
